



Slime time

Now's the perfect time to make your own slime

Try this easy marshmallow slime recipe, and remember to always ask a parent for permission.

Ingredients

- 1 bag of mini marshmallows (100g)
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil (add more, if required)
- ½ cup icing sugar
- Food colouring (optional)
- 1-2 tbsp Rainbow sprinkles

Method

- Microwave marshmallows twice at 30 second intervals to melt them.
- Add in the icing sugar and oil. Mix well.
- Let cool for 15 minutes. Coat your hands in some oil and mix by hand. If it's sticky, continue adding a little oil until it can be held and pliable.
- Mix in food colouring and sprinkles of your choice.
