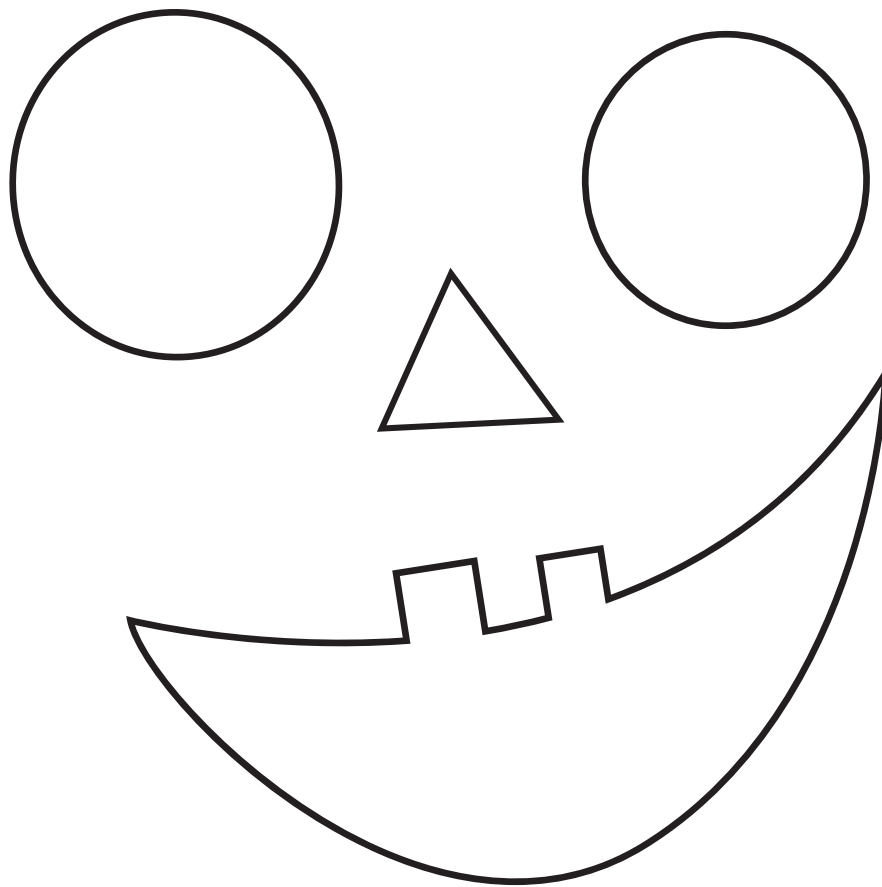


How to carve your Watermelon



1. Use a large knife to cut the top off the watermelon (do not throw away) and scoop out flesh with an icecream scoop
2. Drain the juice out into a bowl or glass (save it and make punch!)
3. Once hollow, secure stencil firmly with tape
4. Trace the outline of the stencil by poking holes using a sharp metal skewer
5. Remove stencil and carve along pattern using paring knife
6. Insert flameless candle and place top of watermelon back on

SAFETY: Ensure carving takes place on a flat, dry surface. Always take care when handling knives.
